### Rescue Dog of the Week guidelines

- Rescue Dog of the Week postings are usually about 250 words long (they can be longer, so please don't feel limited by that number). Include information about house-trained, crate-trained, leash manners, commands mastered (sit, stay, down, etc), temperament (very active, prefers to sleep on the sofa most of the day, gets along with cats, doesn't like other dogs, etc), and the type of adopter that would be best suited for the dog. Besides this basic information, please try to include a little bit of back story about the dog.
- All submissions will be edited for grammar and punctuation; occasionally due to space or other constraints some content might be subject to editing.
- Every article should be accompanied by a minimum of three (3) good quality photos of the rescue dog; at least one should be a horizontal/landscape shot (this will be used at the top of the article). You may submit as many photos as you like, but we reserve the right to choose and/or crop those used in the article. Keep in mind that the more high-quality photos we can include, the more compelling the post will be to the reader. Please don't submit blurry or dark photos; there is only so much we can fix in photoshop.
- Please include your name, email, and phone number with the information so that we can reach you if we have any questions.
- Please also include the following:
  - The link for the rescue/shelter website
  - The link for the Facebook page
  - Contact email for inquiries about adoptions (optional)
  - The location where the dog is being housed (city and state)
